I first moved to 2 Stoke Lodge Cottages 34yrs ago in October 1977 when I was 9 years old. My dad took the job of Caretaker of Stoke Lodge and the cottage was part of his job package. My mum also worked in Stoke Lodge a privilege which I later had when I helped out in lessons throughout my teenage years. I attended Stoke Bishop Primary School where I have since sent my children and where I now work. We had a family dog that moved with us and whom we exercised in the field from day one of moving in.

Although at the time there were grounds men (Kevin and Colin and later William) based in the pavilion on the field in the day time there was no security or cover at night so my dad would act as security at night and on weekends. He saw off many unsavoury characters that were up to no good mainly teenage drinkers climbing over the pavilion. A "tradition" that myself and my husband now find ourselves doing.

At that time there was the main entrance through Stoke Lodge to the field, an entrance to walk through at the bottom of the field leading to Cheyne Road, various entries up Ebenezer Lane, a proper gate entrance next to our garden by the pavilion and a drive through entrance at the top of the field which is still there. Although there was and still is a notice next to the gate entrance by the pavilion banning dog exercise in the 34yrs I have been here people have always disregarded the signs and walked their dogs and have NEVER been ejected from the field not even by the grounds men when they were based here.

As mentioned before we started to walk our dog on the field when we moved here and haven't stopped to this day with the various dogs that we have had since. Whilst I was a child I always met with my friends on the field to play sports games, have picnics and generally catch up as groups of children do. After leaving junior school I attend Cotham Grammar school and then found myself taking PE lessons on Stoke Lodge field as Cotham have the use of the field for their sports facilities.

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Since having my own family we have used the field for our children's exercise and leisure and whilst working at Stoke Bishop Primary School we have also used the field on numerous occasions bringing the children over for various outings.

I can honestly say that except for holidays or illness not a day has passed that we haven't walked on the field for one reason or another. This is partly due to the fact that my cottage is one of two which are within the walls of the field and so the front of our home opens straight out onto the field with an access gate straight onto the grass. Both bedrooms and living room look out straight onto the field and are directly in line with Stoke Lodge and its beautiful mature trees.

When my father passed away myself and my husband immediately put in to buy 2 Stoke Lodge Cottage as it was my home but it had also played such a big part in my life that we didn't want to loose it. We were lucky enough to purchase it in 1994.

As I started to get older I wanted to learn a different language and as we were taking holidays in Greece alot I started 3 years of Greek Lessons at Stoke Lodge as well as attending various one off weekend courses which filtered out onto the gardens and field in the summer. I also attended Photography lessons there and had one of my photos of the front of Stoke Lodge published in their brochure in the 1980s.

Obviously living here for over 3 decades and my families involvement with Stoke Lodge, a wooden bench is still dedicated to my father's service in the foyer of the building to this day, any change or prevention of our daily use of the field and its natural beauty would be heart wrenching and a very, very sad loss.

The field has offered me and my family, past and present, leisure, space, natural beauty, wildlife, security and a social life. I have seen many people come and go over 3 decades but have only seen a hand full of trees fall in that same time. I have seen the pavilion set alight and burn and be rebuilt in that time but it is still here, I have seen children play then come back with their children in that time as the field has always remained an open free safe space for people to enjoy and introduce their families to time and time again.

The thing I most value about Stoke Lodge is the large part it has always played in my life and still does. After all this time I can open my window and still hear the foxes calling, the owls hooting or squirrels screeching and breath in the fresh air and have the feeling of being in the country although we are in the middle of a bustling busy town.

To have this taken away from me and my family after all this time would be the equivalent of taking away more than half my life.

I believe that the facts stated in this witness statement are true.

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

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
