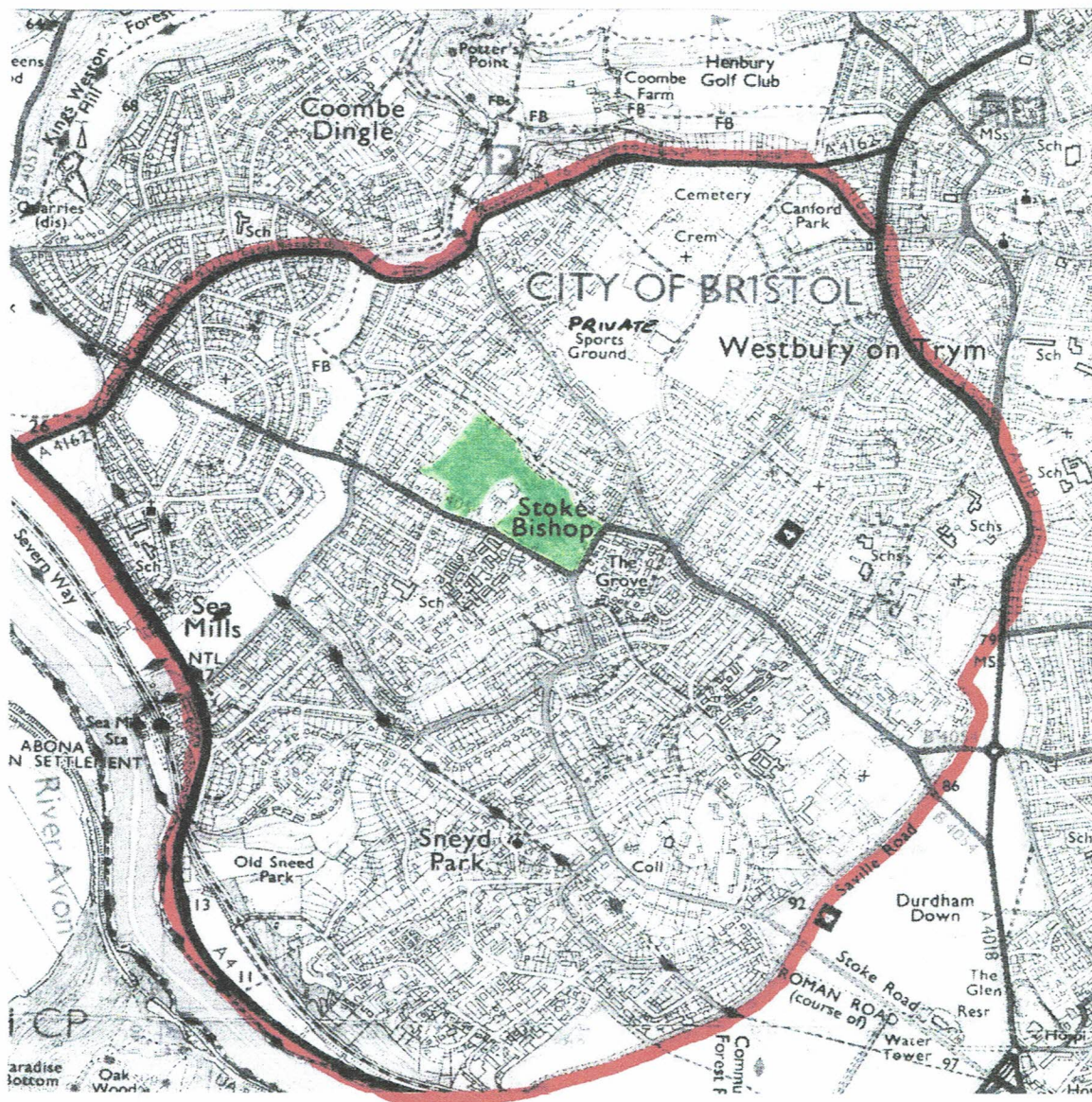

**Application for the registration of Land as a Town or Village Green**  
**at Stoke Lodge Parkland, Stoke Bishop, Bristol, BS9 1BN**  
**Neighbourhood Plan**



This plan identifies the Neighbourhood for this Application, and is defined by the area contained within the red line. This area is bounded by the river Avon on the south west, the A 4162 on the northwest, the A 4018 on the north east and Durdham Downs and Clifton Downs on the southeast. (Please see OS map extract used as a background to the above plan attached)

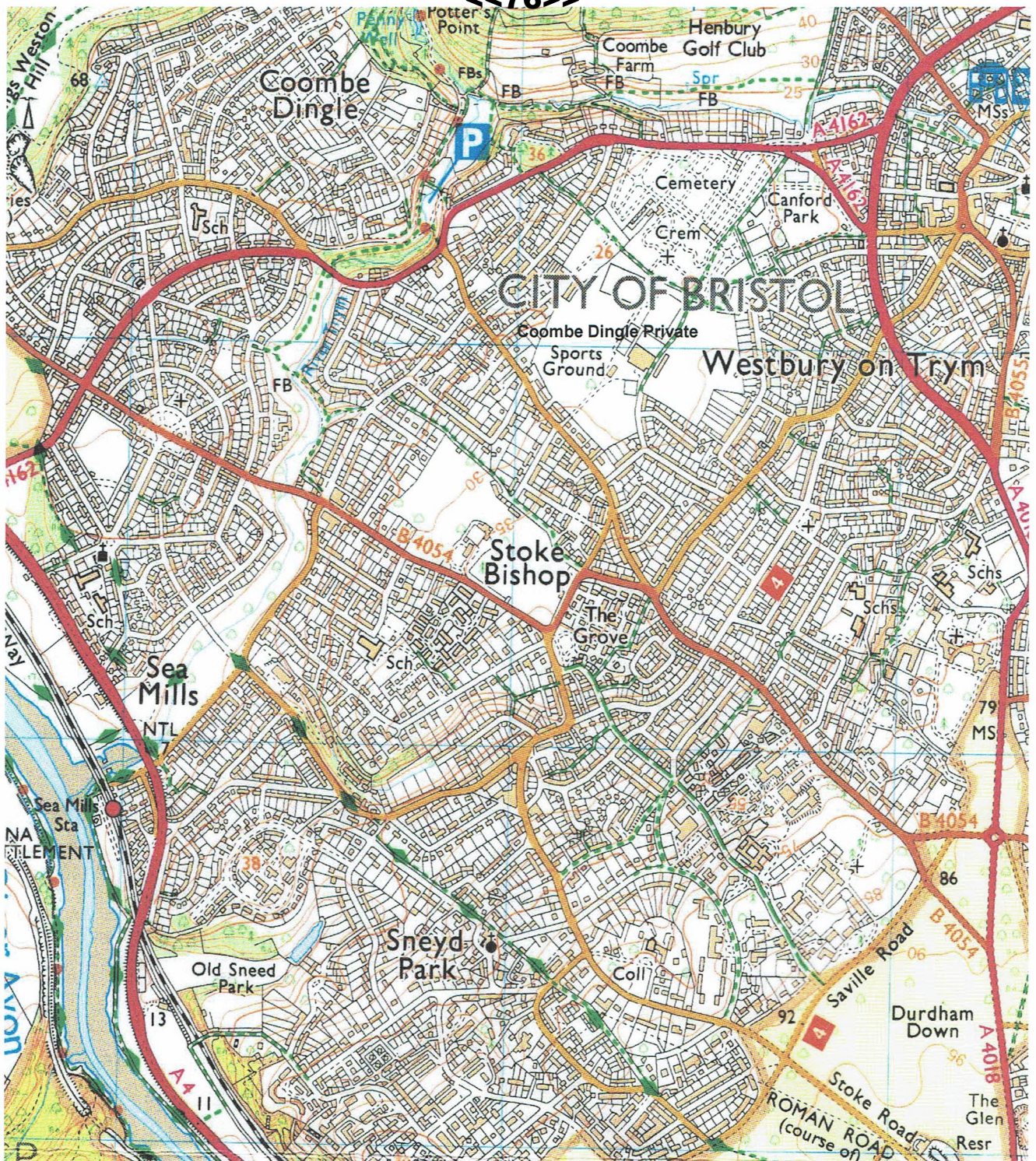
This area includes the home location of the majority of regular users of Stoke Lodge Parkland, identified as 86% of total use in the survey of use conducted in August 2010, (see evidence tab 19), and has a radius of approximately 0.75 miles, (or 1.2 km).

The Application site is contained within the locality defined by the Polling District of Stoke Bishop; but the Neighbourhood (centred on the Application site) extends into the localities defined by the Polling District of Westbury on Trym and the Sea Mills portion of the Polling District of Kingsweston. (Please see Polling District plans attached)

Post Application Note: In 2015 the Local Government Boundary Commission revised the Polling District of Stoke Bishop to include precisely the area of Sea Mills contained in the Neighbourhood plan above.



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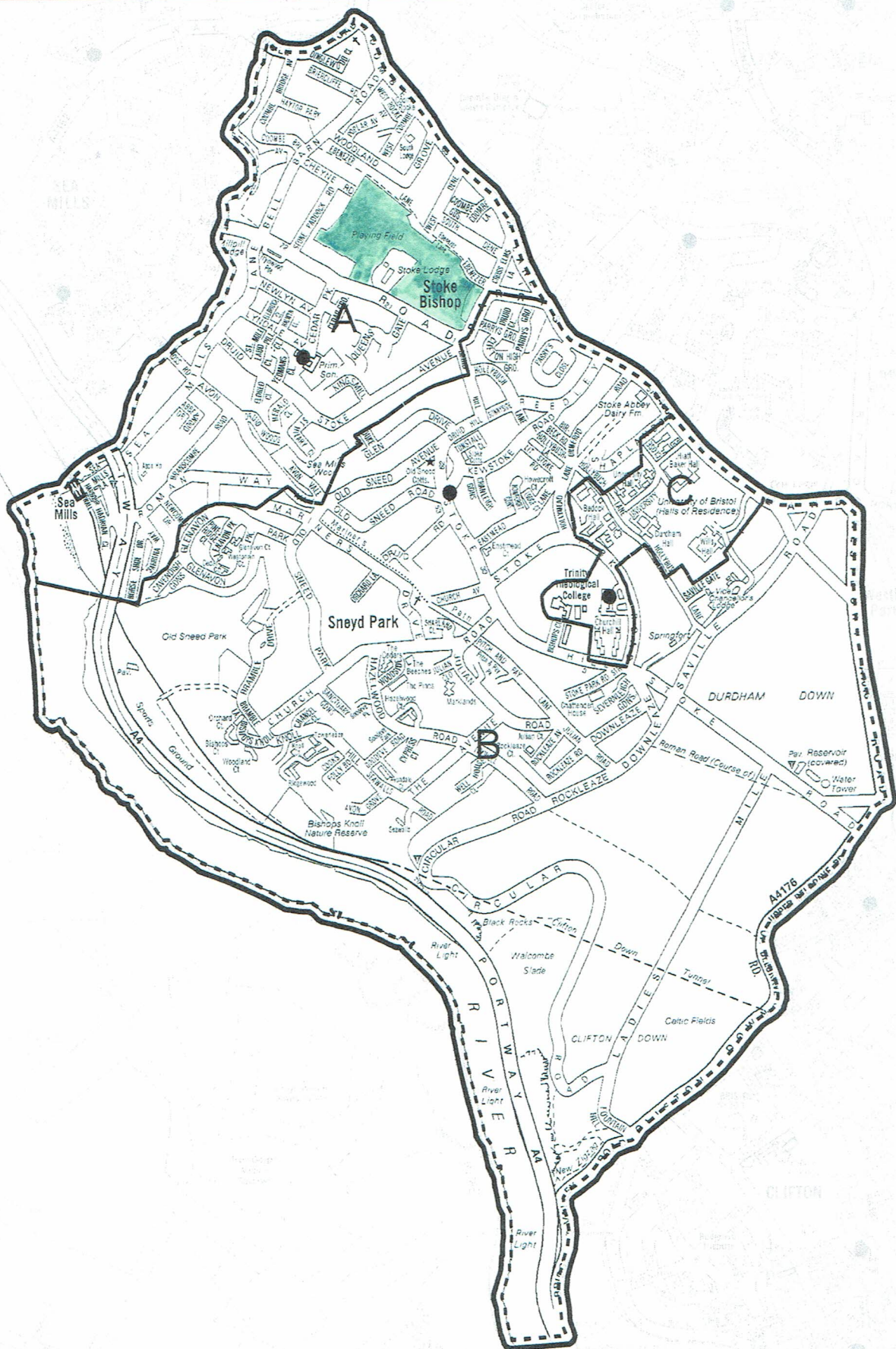

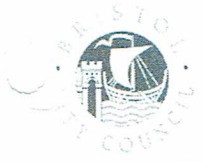




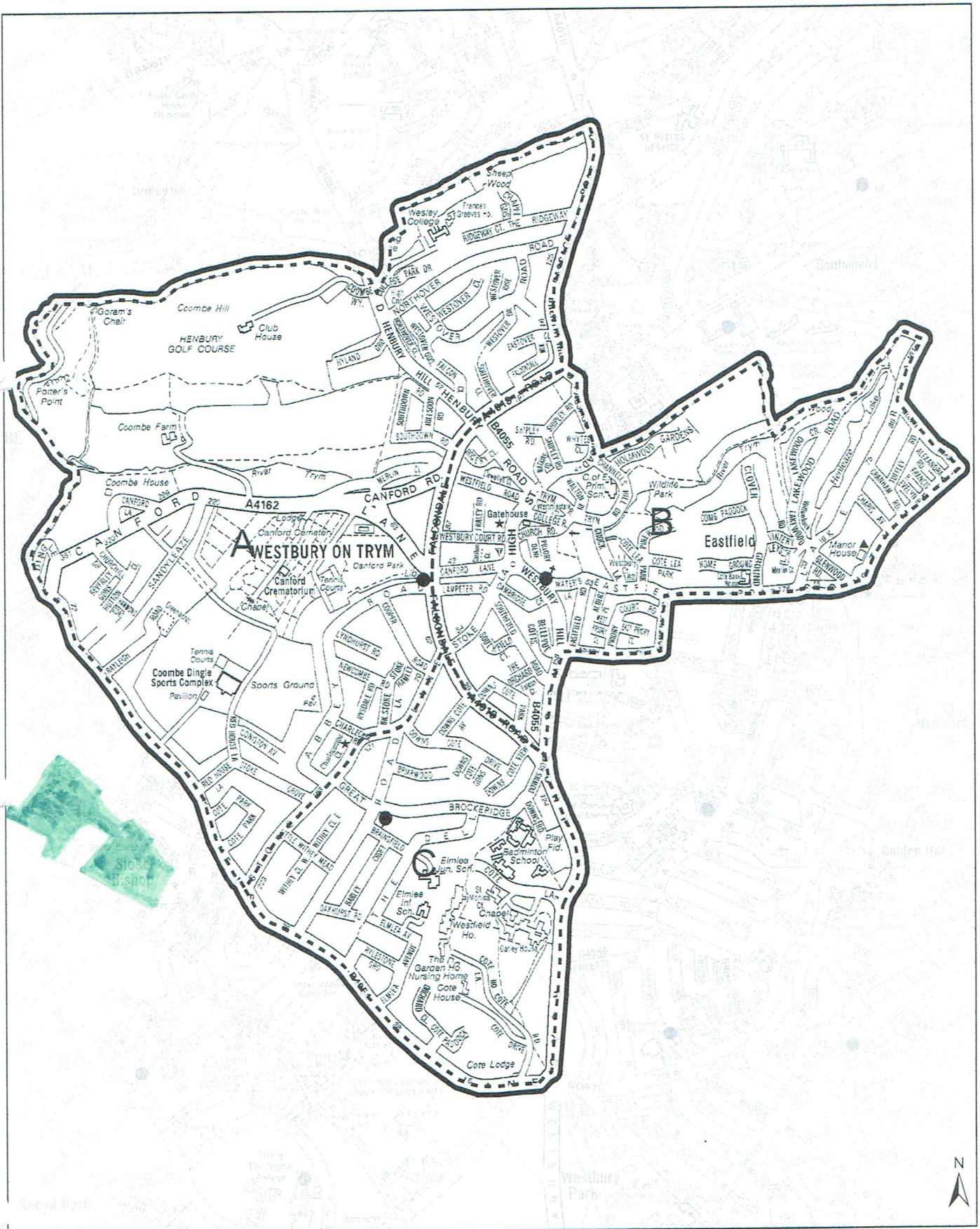
# Stoke Bishop Polling Districts







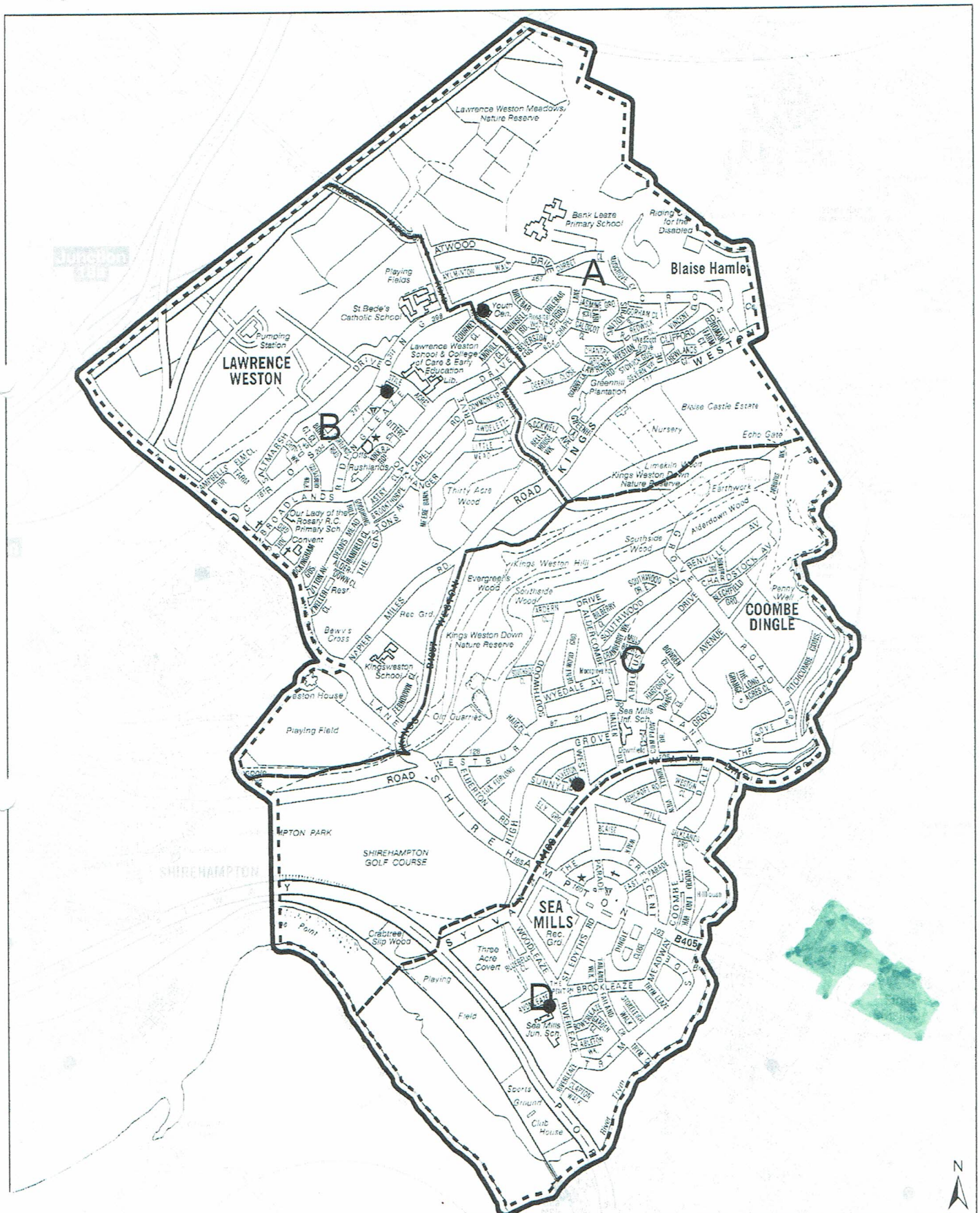
# Westbury-on-Trym Polling Districts
