The date for the Judicial Review has now been set as 21st and 22nd November 2017 and will be held at the Bristol Civil and Family Justice Centre, 2 Redcliff St, Bristol, BS1 6GR. Telephone 01 173 664 800.

The Defendant (BCC) and any interested party (us) must submit detailed grounds for contesting the claim, already submitted, by Cotham to the Court by 15th June 2017.

The Claimant (Cotham) must submit their skeleton arguments together with their bundle of documents by 23rd October 2017.

The Defendant (BCC) and any interested party (us) must submit their skeleton arguments together with their bundle of documents by 1st November 2017.

Thanks to your generosity we are able to fund the preparation of these documents and be represented at the Hearing by DAC Beachcroft and our barrister.

On a separate but related matter the planning consultant (CSJ Planning) employed by Cotham has submitted a Transport Statement in support of the planning application to develop a new pavilion at Stoke Lodge. Planning ref **17/00864/F**

The principal of replacing the existing pavilion is sound; but the current proposal is flawed in a number of areas including trespassing on designated TVG Land. However this Transport Statement (copy attached) is deeply flawed and factually incorrect in if left unchallenged will misinform and mislead the planning officers when considering the merits of the application. In particular Cotham have not used Stoke Lodge since 2014 and hence their claim that there is an established transport process in place is wholly unfounded. Please refer to paragraphs 2.1, 2.11, 2.12, 2.13, 2.14, 3.4, 3.9, 3.10, 3.11, 3.12 and 3.13.
